The guest speaker for April was Sue-Ellen Shaw, who represented the Great Southern Alliance. This is an organisation formed in 2015, to promote the

economic interests of the City of Albany, the Shire of Denmark and the Shire of Plantagenet. It aims to encourage growth in agriculture, industry and tourism, and streamline the marketing process by combining forces under the logo "Amazing Great Southern."

The three local authorities have signed a memorandum of understanding to work together in promoting the region, rather than competing with one another.
